



Broccoli Chowder

2 tablespoons canola oil 1/2 cup chopped onion 3 cloves garlic, finely minced 1/2 cup chopped carrots 2 cups diced, unpeeled red

3 cups broccoli florets 1/2 teaspoon dried Italian 1/2 teaspoon salt

31/2 cups low sodium chicken broth 1/2 cup half-and-half 1/2 cup low-fat, shredded cheese

all-purpose flour

In a large heavy pot, heat the oil over medium heat. Add the onion and garlic and sauté 2-3 minutes. Add the carrots, red notatoes and broccoli one at a time. sauté each about 2 minutes. Add the Italian seasoning, salt, pepper and flour and toss until vegetables are coated. Cook 1-2 minutes. Add the chicken broth and bring to a boil. Reduce heat to low, cover pot and simmer for 15


