



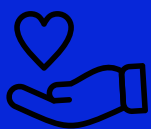

50 educational programs were offered in Lyon County in the areas of agriculture, horticulture and natural resources



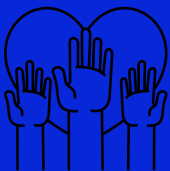

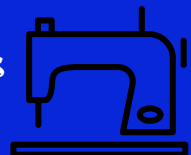
